Scholarships

Awards for high school seniors and college students studying any tech discipline, at the institution of their choice.

Mentorship

Pairing scholars with a seasoned tech professional for guidance through school and into the job.

Internships & job shadowing

Paid seats on real technology teams. The step that turns a degree into employment.

Advocacy, for the long haul
